Welcome to Rijeka!

The first known settlement on the site of today's Rijeka was Flumen Sancti Viti in the 13th century. This name was given after the river Rječina, which flows through the city center, while the modern name "Rijeka" means "river", so people often refer to Rijeka as "the city that flows".

Rijeka is the third largest city in Croatia and the largest Croatian port. Throughout its history, it has been an important industrial site with numerous factories, including the Torpedo fabric (Rijeka was recognized as the hometown of the torpedo). In recent years, the industrial buildings have been used as cultural facilities and tourist attractions. Former warehouses and factories are now being transformed into museums, concert halls and libraries. In 2020, Rijeka was named European Capital of Culture and hosted numerous art and music events. Some of the city's tourist attractions are:

- Art Neighbourhood with museums, library and children's house
- The Church of Our Lady in Trsat
- Trsat Castle
- Tunnel
- City Tower

Places around Rijeka:


You will find numerous tourist attractions in the surroundings of Rijeka. Here we present only a short list of suggestions:

- Cultural-touristic route <u>"The Routes of the Frankopans</u>", which includes 17 castles and forts and 3 church buildings
- Grobnik Circuit, a race track for cars and motorcycles
- Gorski kotar with its beautiful forests
- Opatija, the oldest tourist destination in Croatia
- Crikvenica





How to get to Rijeka?



Rijeka airport:

- Located on the island of Krk, about 10 km from the city center
- Connected to 18 destinations
- An official bus shuttle service connects the airport with the city center

Zagreb airport:

- About 150 km from Rijeka
- Connected to 75 destinations
- An official shuttle bus service connects the airport with Rijeka

Trieste airport:

- About 70 km from Rijeka
- Offers daily long-haul coach service to Rijeka




Rijeka bus terminal is directly connected to 14 European destinations. Information about bus tickets can be found on webpages of <u>Arriva</u> and <u>FlixBus</u> companies.







- From West and North: arrive to Slovenia and connect to A7 highway at Rupa
- From East: arrive to Zagreb and connect to A1 and turn to A6 at Bosiljevo
- From South: connect to A1 and arrive to Bosiljevo, then connect to A6 highway
